ORDER

WOLF, D.J. August 6, 2018

For the reasons explained at the August 2, 2018 hearing, it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. Lead Plaintiffs' Motion for Final Approval of Class Action Settlement and Plan of Allocation (Docket No. 125) is ALLOWED.

2. Lead Counsel's Motion for an Award of Attorneys' Fees and Reimbursement of Litigation Expenses (Docket No. 127), which includes a request to reimburse the lead plaintiffs for the time their employees spent prosecuting this action, is taken under advisement.

3. Lead plaintiff Arkansas Teacher Retirement System ("ATRS") shall, by August 6, 2018, file an affidavit explaining

how it determined the number of hours its employees spent on this litigation. See Declaration of Rod Graves (Docket No. 129-7), ¶14.¹

¹ Counsel for lead plaintiffs City of Omaha Police and Fire Retirement System and City of Bristol Pension Fund stated that the numbers of hours for which those entities seek reimbursement, see Declaration of Diane Waldron (Docket Nos. 129-8), ¶6 and Declaration of James Sklenar (Docket Nos. 129-9), ¶6, were based on the declarants' personal knowledge of the time employees spent on this case, and conversations with those employees, and that the relevant employees did not contemporaneously record their time. However, counsel for ATRS stated that he believed, although he did not know, that ATRS kept contemporaneous time records. Therefore, the court is seeking additional information from ATRS, but not the other lead plaintiffs.
